

2007-2008 NCAA Primary Accident Medical Program

Eligibility: Only schools participating in the NCAA Group Medical Program are eligible to purchase this coverage.

Plan Option: Option A: Zero deductible with \$5,000 accident medical maximum

Policy Structure:

1. Provides primary coverage while participating in covered athletic events only.
2. The policy will provide mandatory coverage for all uninsured Intercollegiate student-athletes, student-coaches, student-managers, student-trainers, and student-cheerleaders who elect to purchase it.
3. The school must provide a roster of all of their uninsured Intercollegiate student-athletes, student-coaches, student-managers, student-trainers, and student-cheerleaders at the time of purchase.

Premium:

1. The premium for Option A is \$365 per person per policy year.
2. All of the premium is due at the effective date of coverage.

- All student-athletes who decide to enroll in the NCAA Primary Accident Medical Program must pay \$365 in full to the OPSU Athletic Department. The Athletic Department then submits the student's information and payment to NCAA.
