Allie Mitchell Scholarships

Allie Margaret Mitchell, 90, passed away on August 30, 2006. The daughter of Texas County pioneer family, Della Rachel (Frazier) and Franklin Lunsford, she was born May 26, 1916 at the family place 20 miles northwest of Guymon.

She moved to Missouri in 1938 and to Kansas City to work in 1942. She was united in marriage to Roy Benton Mitchell on October 18, 1945 in Kansas City. The Mitchell family came to Texas County that year and made their home in the Hough area where they farmed. Allie and Roy were charter members of the Morning Star United Methodist Church. They moved into Guymon in 1986 and Mr. Mitchell passed away April 13, 1992. Allie had been an active member of the Victory Center United Methodist Church.

Mrs. Mitchell was a generous and loyal contributor to the Panhandle State Foundation. She established the Roy B. Mitchell Scholarship through Panhandle State Foundation in memory of her husband in 1992. Allie was an instructor of Economics for the university. She was a Foundation board member from 2004 until her death in 2006 at the age of 90.

The Allie Mitchell Scholarships are given from interest distributions from a trust Mrs. Mitchell set up with the Oklahoma United Methodist Foundation. The number of scholarships varies per year.
