Carol Beesley, M.F.A is one of the guest artists for the 21st Annual Art Jubilee, Wednesday, April 10th, 2019. Carol resides in Norman Oklahoma where she is a Professor Emeritus of Art at The University of Oklahoma's College of Fine Arts where she taught for 24 years. Carol received her M.F.A. from the University of California in Los Angeles. Norman artist Carol Beesley's paintings could be described as riots of color. That's not to say they're out of control or unwelcome. Beesley's canvases are often enormous and draw liberally from nature's palette of colors including some shades seldom seen in the wild. The National Endowment for the Humanities fellowship recipient has been widely celebrated for her renderings of New Mexican arroyos, mountain vistas and deep, mysterious canyons.

During the Jubilee Carol will demonstrate recent discoveries in materials and techniques painting on fabrics. She will share where to get the fabrics. For professional development classes on Tuesday April 9th on she will be showing how to create collages using pens as well. This class is also open to the public.
