Presidential Award: (Renewable)

- >Valedictorian
- >26 or above ACT composite or Minimum 1170 SAT composite (see below)
- >First time Freshman

>8 semester renewable value- \$11,600

***\$2000.00/yr**

**plus room

Outstanding Student Award: (Renewable)

- >Salutatorian
- >24-25 ACT composite or Minimum 1080 SAT composite (see below)
- >First time Freshman

>8 semester renewable value- \$7,600

***\$1000.00/yr**

**plus room

Educational Achievement Award: (Renewable)

- >22-23 ACT composite or Minimum 1010 SAT composite (see below)
- >First time Freshman
- >Transfer students 3.0 minimum GPA

>8 semester renewable value- \$2,000

***\$500.00/yr**

Educational Incentive Award: (Non-renewable)

- >18-21 ACT composite or Minimum 860 SAT composite (see below)
- >First time Freshman
- >Transfer students 2.5 minimum GPA

***\$300.00/yr**

Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship: (Renewable)

- >Transfer Students from a 2-year college with active PTK chapters
- >Minimum 3.25 GPA on a Minimum of 30 semester hours
- >Proof of membership in Phi Theta Kappa
- >Renewable with 30 hours/year, full-time status, and cumulative 3.0 GPA

>4 semester renewable value- \$2,000

***\$1000.00/yr**

* for tuition up to 30 hours

SAT composite based on Critical Reading and Math scores

** \$450 bed waiver

Re-Application Standards:

To be eligible for an academic scholarship the student must:

1. Maintain a specific cumulative grade point average:
 - ◆ Presidential: 3.25
 - ◆ Outstanding Student: 3.25
 - ◆ Educational Achievement: 3.00
2. Must complete 30 hours per year.
3. **Reapply annually** through OPSU High School Relations Office, from January 1– May 1.
4. Scholarships are in competition with other applicants.
5. Open to continuing OPSU students that meet above criteria.
6. Subject to availability of funds.
