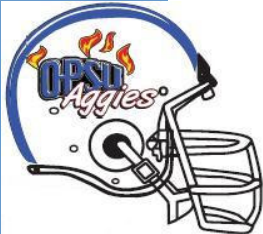


GIVING BACK TO THE PROGRAM

- Lease a Photocopy Machine



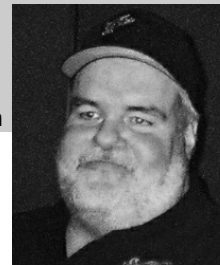

AGGIE FOOTBALL FORTUNES GO BACK TO THE FUTURE

When Mike Wyatt was named as the new Aggie Head Football Coach, one of their own returned to Goodwell. Wyatt graduated from OPSU, but also was an Aggie assistant coach from 1979 to 1981.

Wyatt brings an overall record as a head football coach at all levels of 222-79-2. Most recently, the Grandfield, Oklahoma, native had been coaching indoor football in St. Louis for the RiverCity Rage, where he took over a team that was 7-33 in franchise history and guided them to a 33-13 record during his tenure including a 14-2 mark in 2006. Wyatt's career also boasts 13 years in Europe where his teams set European total offense and passing records including having 3 receivers catch more than 1,000 yards in passes during 2003.
