STUDENT INTERN AGREEMENT

Between Oklahoma Panhandle State University of Goodwell, OK

And

Public Schools cooperating in the Student Intern Program

To promote mutual understanding and cooperative effort in providing valuable professional experiences in off-campus student internship (student teaching), the following provisions are recognized by the university and the public school concerned as being essential:

- I. The University Agrees
 - A. To provide the appointed representative of the cooperating school with advance information about the student intern and to indicate the time period request for student assignments.
 - B. To provide adequate supervision of student interns through classroom visitations and conferences with cooperating teachers, student interns, and school administrative personnel.
 - C. To work cooperatively with Public School personnel and student interns in constantly seeking to improve the student intern program.
 - D. To maintain close communications with the appointed personnel of the school district with respect to cancellations or changes this may occur in any student intern assignment, or any problem arising concerning the student intern.
- II. The Cooperating School Agrees
 - A. To provide a student intern assignment of twelve (12) weeks in which all-day participation by the student intern in school and related activities is held when possible.
 - B. To recommend outstanding and certified cooperating teachers willing to work with the student intern(s).
 - C. To provide the Director of Student Teaching with reports of the progress of student interns.
- III. The placement of a student intern shall be a cooperative venture involving both the university and the cooperating school district.
